Nota general: Title devised The manuscript consist of 320 unnumbered leaves, including 167 sheets of Turkish silhouette paper, 71 sheets of Turkish marbled paper, 21 sheets sprinkled with gold and silver, and 61 sheets, some of which are glazed or burnished. It is illustrated with 140 hand-painted miniatures, including 110 coats-of-arms, many of which are painted in gold, silver and other heraldic tinctures, and 30 hand-painted miniatures of Istanbul, Venice, a Commedia dell'Arte scene, armorial supporters, standard bearers, men-of-war, Turkish scenes, a representation of Leda and the Swan, and other scenes The name of Johann Prack von Asch is mentioned in Latin on leaf 136 recto: Joannis Joachimi Prack ab Asch, and on leaf 254 recto: Nobili viro dmo Johanni Joachimo Prack ab Asch; and in Italian on leaf 170 recto: Amico Joanni Joachimo Brack de Asch
