Nota general: Consists of [11] sections, each devoted to a leader of victorious European resistance to the Turks in the Austro-Turkish War of 1716-1718. Each section contains a three-part prose encomium of the leader's activity, concluded by brief Latin verses on the same with German translation. The subjects of sections [9] and [10] are groups of lesser military figures, while that of section [11] is "Der Triumphierende Fried." Associated with each section is an engraved portrait of its subject, with supporters, attributes and a vignette German and Latin Title printed in red and black Of the 3 plates that are signed by the artist, no. [1] is after Johann Georg Bergmüller and no. [10]-[11] are after Melchior Steidl. All plates but the last are signed by the engraver, Jacob Andreas Fridrich Signatures: [pi]1)(2)()² A-S²
