This article analyzes the attitude of the Basque political emigration in America towards the paradiplomatic strategy which was carried out by the Basque Government in-exile between 1936 and 1953. For that purpose, we have selected the Mexican and Argentinian editions of the Euzko Deya's newspaper in order to rebuild the Basque communities' opinions, particularly those of political exile, before three facts of special relevance: Spanish Civil War, the disappearance of president Aguirre during World War II and the attitude of USA with respect to Spain at the UNO

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
