From Hydatius's narration, the article tries to identify the developing of power in Gallaecia in fifth century and in those parts of Hispania under barbarian rule after the 409's invasion. It shows two basic structures of power: one in the cities, arised firom Late Empire tradition and incamated in men of high social extraction, and the other in country, based in communitarian forms and arised from pre-roman tradition. Both of them are product of the atomization of power after the vanishing of Roman Empire in Hispania

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
