In this paper I analyze the recast of Calderón's *No hay cosa como callar* by Bretón de los Herreros, performed for the first time in 1827. Bretón recasted ten pieces from the Spanish Golden Age theater, five out of them from Calderón. As usual in nineteenth-century recasts, Breton respects the plot of the classical comedy, but he adjusts its action to the unities of time and place imposed by the neoclassical norms, while modifying the verses in order to obtain greater clarity and simplicity of expression.
