



Adaptación en adolescentes infractores bajo sistema de responsabilidad penal [

The objective of this study was to describe and compare the level of personal adjustment, school, family and social system juvenile offenders under criminal liability modalities: A socio-familial and institutional environment in the city of Yopal. A comparative descriptive design was used. This was applied to 40 young people (20 in each group) under the system of criminal liability for the Test adolescent self reported Multifactor Adaptation (TAMAI). Results revealed that adolescents in both groups showed significant levels of family maladjustment and low levels of school maladjustment. Comparing the groups showed that there were statistically significant differences at the level of personal maladjustment, social and family levels being more serious maladjustment in the institutionalized group than in the family environment.
