



Adaptación hispana y validación de la escala de respuesta a la incertidumbre [

Objective. This study reports on the results of the Hispanic adaptation and validation of the Uncertainty Response Scale (URS) carried out with a sample of Venezuelan university professors. **Method.** A validation study in which the original English 48-item scale was used (Greco y Roger, 2001), which measures three dimensions of facing, or responding to, uncertainty: emotional uncertainty, desire to change, and cognitive uncertainty. When translated, it was applied to a sample of 140 professors of the Universidad Simón Bolívar (Caracas-Venezuela). **Results.** The results of the factorial analysis reduced the Hispanic version of the scale to 45 items, while maintaining the structure of three well-differentiated dimensions, and which was named the Escala de Respuesta a la Incertidumbre - ERI. This scale, together with other measures for facing situations, and health indicators was subsequently applied to a different sample of 198 Venezuelan university professors, and the results supported the concurrent and predictive validity of each dimension. **Conclusion.** The URS, therefore, is a valid instrument for measuring the response to the uncertainty in individuals, and with wide applications in the area of psychology

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
