Nevertheless, it is an opportunity for the US for it allows American investors intellectual property rights over traditional Indian knowledge without having to abide by the CDB principles nor Andean decisions No. 391, 486 and 523. As such, the Free Trade Agreement not only disavows the norms issued by the Andean Community of Nations but it also acts as a force over the international biodiversity policies adopted by 188 parties within the framework of the CDB

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
