Zapotec migration from San Blas Atempa, Isthmus of Tehuantepec, Oaxaca, to Ensenada, Baja California, Mexico (1970-2018), begins and reaffirms itself through female led experiences. Historically women have been taken the leadership roles in the migratory networks and in the dynamics of labour insertion of their community. This article analyses this articulation, between feminine migratory networks and experiences of labour insertion, through the Zapotec "nicho laboral" (labour niche) par excellence in the city of Ensenada: domestic service. The data presented are part of a long-term ethnographic research carried out from 2014 to 2018. The methodological approach is qualitative. Testimonies are analysed seeking to emphasize the workers perspective. The value of this article lies in showing the existence of agency dynamics and labour dignity in a highly ethnic and feminized labour sector in Mexico
