Based on the fundamental idea that we can make contributions from and within our communities to social change, based on democracy, equality, freedom and justice, we decided to develop this program within the framework of the investigation, reflection, action (IRA) which allowed us to study and analyze problematic that indigenous women face daily, through the design and confection of a participative diagnostic and the planning and implementation of workshops related to a political ideological perspective influenced by the social economical context, marked by marginality, migration, and lack of opportunities for development, having as main purposes, to open information, organization and participation channels for the citizens. Results showed that all participants acknowledged the importance of social organization and that it can be used as a dispositive for community development; furthermore, conformation of a citizen agenda and an Indigenous Women Regional Council was accomplished. Method employed was most suitable for intervention, since it allowed to move from an initial level of problematic knowledge to a higher reflection level where people built and proposed solution alternatives -from their own context and experience- for acting consciously upon their reality and transform it for collective benefit. So, we state that the relevance of this research lies in the accomplish of social organization for the common wealth, through the development of this valuable method (IRA), which permits a wide social analysis and promote people's organization and autonomy upon their own political ideological perspective

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
