In this article, we will analyze one of the visits that the German Wilhelm Marr made to Nicaragua and Costa Rica. Based in a diary of the journey, title in Spanish as: Viaje a Centroamérica (2004) from the original: Reise nach Central-Amerika (1863), it was the result of this voyage in the Isthmus between 1852 and 1853. We pretend to trail his personal annotations, the ideological perspective of a German and the internalization of the human and natural space that he found in his trip. So determine the relation of the other discourse: North-South; that is the definition and apprehension of the environment from his own euro-centric visualization. This is preceded by a historic reencounter of the colonialism in America from XVI to the XX century with particular emphasis in Central America

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
