

Atuação da enfermeira na dor do cliente cardiológico: Um estudo frente o reconhecimento das intervenções de enfermagem [

Objectives: To identify acknowledgement of Acute Pain diagnosis, through its defining characteristics, by nurses in a coronary intensive care unit, correlate their interventions to the nomenclature established for Classification of suggested and optional Nursing Interventions. Method: Qualitative, descriptive study, realized with thirteen nurses from the Coronary Care Unit of a hospital in Rio de Janeiro. Results: of the eighteen defining characteristics described by NANDA, only seven of the nurses interviewed are recognized. Among twenty-seven possible interventions described in the Nursing Care Intervention (NIC), only seven are recognized, and, the majority ruled in the administration of analgesics, which affects nursing actions directed to the biomedical model. Conclusion: It is necessary that nurses reflect on the patient's individual needs, valorizing a care that involves a complex set of actions beyond biomedical care, ruled in comfort measures that promote the reduction of this symptom and consequently the improvement in the quality of care

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
