To contribute to this kind of studies private letters from Vigo and A Coruña to Buenos Aires, dated between 1767 and 1806, have been syntactically analyzed in this paper. These letters are written in Spanish but some linguistic phenomena may be understood through Spanish and Galician language contact.
