This article is part of a broader investigation aimed at demonstrating the knowledge of three "origin communities" from the "Mitad del Mundo" located in the Ecuadorian Andes: Kitu Kara, Kayampi and Karanki. The study area focused on the Cochasquí archaeological park, located in Quito, in the province of Pichincha. This document shows the technical development of the original populations of the Ecuadorian territory and their approach to astronomy, represented in cultural expressions, rituals, and festivities. Through dances performed during the celebration of solstices and equinoxes, especially the summer solstice, we seek to demonstrate the relationship that exists between astronomy and the cosmovision of Andean peoples manifesting itself in understandings of nature and its phenomena, the observation and abstraction of life cycles, and the movement of atmospheric elements and celestial bodies

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
