The main aim of the article is to propose a basic comparative scheme of the so-called charismatic and ecstatic religious movements. The scheme consists of three fundamental analytical axes: conversion, the religious experience and charisma. It is based on research about the Hare Krishna movement, and a subsequent ethnographic study carried out in three evangelical churches of Mexico. The first section contextualizes the implementation and growth of pentecostal Protestantism in Latin America in general, and Mexico in particular. Then the comparative synthesis focuses on the experience of conversion, the ideological and ritual management of the body, and the symbolic and organizational power of charisma.

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
