In correlation to the development of communication technologies, the possibilities to access, share, generate, and even commoditize knowledge have significantly increased throughout the last three decades. Relying on a public-private agreement, governments are disposed to optimize their strategy to manage knowledge. The inquiry questions whether this paradigm contributes to the diminishment or reinforcement of epistemological hierarchies and, therefore, whether it challenges or deepens socio-economic, as well as cultural gaps

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
