Hark! the herald angels sing; Good news from heaven the angels bring; Thou didst leave Thy throne; Come hither, ye faithful; One in royal David's city; The new-born King Who comes today; Joy to the world! the Lord is come; Silent night! Holy night!; Hark! how the angels sing -- Christmas carols. Come! ye lofty, come! ye lowly; O little town of Bethlehem; While shepherds watched their flocks; It came upon the midnight clear; Joy fills our inmost hearts today; The joyful morn is breaking; See, amid the winter's snow; Like silver lamps in a distant shrine; God rest you, merry gentlemen; Stars all bright are beaming; In the silence of the night; Come and hear the grand old story; Good Christian men, rejoice; The first Noel the angel did say; There dwelt in old Judea; When Christ was born of Mary free; Sing, sing for Christmas; Child Jesus came from heaven to earth; Away in a manger; 'Tis Christmas Day; Carol, sweetly carol -- Name of Jesus. At the name of Jesus; Jesus! Name of wondrous love; To the Name of our salvation; How sweet the Name of Jesus sounds -- Epiphany. Brightest and best of the sons of the morning; As with gladness men of old; O Thou, Who by a star didst guide; Hail to the Lord's Anointed; From the eastern mountains -- Epiphany carols. There came three kings; We three kings of Orient are; There's a beautiful star; There's a song in the air -- Lent. In the Cross of Christ I glory; Sweet the moments, rich in blessing; Hail, Thou once despised Jesus; I adore Thee; Holy Jesus, by Thy Passion; Wide open are Thy hands; Lord of mercy and of might; Jesus, and shall it ever be; O Lamb of God, still keep me; Jesus, meek and lowly; Art thou weary, art thou languid; Jesus, tender Saviour; Thy life was given for me; Jesus, keep

me near the Cross -- Palm Sunday. All glory, laud, and honor; When, His salvation bringing; Hosanna we sing; Hosanna! loud hosanna! -- Holy week. O Thou, Who through this Holy Week; There is a green hill far away; When I survey the wondrous Cross; O come and mourn with me awhile; Glory be to Jesus; O Sacred Head, now wounded; Into the woods my Master went -- Easter. The day of Resurrection; Christ, the Lord, is risen today (2 versions); Jesus Christ is risen today; Welcome, happy morning -- Easter carols, O joyous Easter morning; Christ is risen! Alleluia!; Angels, roll the rock away; Come, ye faithful, raise the strain; God hath sent His angels to the earth again; The world itself keeps Easter Day; Ye happy bells of Easter Day; Let the merry church bells ring; Easter flowers are blooming bright; Now all the bells are ringing -- Ascension. Golden harps are sounding; See the Conqueror mounts in triumph: Look, ye saints! the sight is glorious -- Whitsunday-The Holy Spirit. Let songs of praises fill the sky; Holy Spirit, Truth divine; Holy Spirit, hear us; Come, Holy Spirit, God and Lord; Holy Ghost, with light divine; Come, gracious Spirit, heavenly Dove; Come, Holy Ghost, in love (2 versions); Come, Holy Ghost, our souls inspire; Blest Spirit, one with God above -- Trinity Sunday-The Holy Trinity. Holy, Holy, Holy! Lord God Almighty: Holy, Holy Lord (2 versions): Blessed Father, Great Creator: Come. Thou Almighty King; Ancient of Days, Who sittest throned in glory; Round the Lord in glory seated; Lead us, heavenly Father, lead us The word. Thy Word, O Lord, like gentle dews; O Word of God Incarnate; Father of mercies, in Thy Word; Lord, Thy Word abideth; Spread, O spread, thou mighty Word; Lord, keep us steadfast in Thy Word; Lo, on a mount a tree doth stand; Thy Word is like a garden, Lord -- Holy baptism. God of eternal Love; Lamb of God, for sinners slain; I was made a Christian; Saviour, Who Thy flock art feeding; Baptized into Thy Name --The Holy Communion. Let Thy Blood in mercy poured; Lord, when before Thy throne we meet The church. Foundation and reformation. I love Thy Zion, Lord; O where are kings and empires now; Zion stands with hills surrounded; A mighty Fortress is our God; The Church's one foundation; Glorious things of thee are spoken; Through the night of doubt and sorrow; My Church, my Church, my dear old Church; Faith of our fathers, living still; Lift up the voice! Sing songs of praise!; Lord of the living harvest -- The ministry, Lord, pour Thy spirit from on high; O Thou Whose feet have climbed life's hill -- Instruction and confirmation. O Lord, Thy benediction give ; Teach me, O teach me, Lord, Thy way; Saviour, teach me, day by day; My God, accept my heart this day; Father, Son, and Holy Spirit; Hushed was the evening hymn; Thine forever! God of Love; I think, when I read that sweet story; Blessed Saviour, who hast taught me; Shine Thou upon us, Lord; Sing them over again to me; O Jesus, I have promised -- Missions. Tell it out among the heathen; Hasten, Lord, the glorious time; From Greenland's icy mountains; Who is on the Lord's side?; O Zion, haste; Saviour, sprinkle many nations; Thou, Whose almighty Word; Arm of the Lord, awake; Christ for the world we sing; Heralds of Christ who bear the King's commands; Fling out the banner; Look from Thy sphere of endless day; The whole wide world for Jesus; Where cross the crowded ways; The morning light is breaking -- The Lord's house. Angel voices ever singing; Lord of the worlds above; We love the place, O God; Christ, Thou art the sure Foundation; Pleasant are Thy courts above -- The Church triumphant. O worship the King; We thank Thee, Lord, for this fair earth; Glory be to God the Father; Praise to the Lord; Mighty God, while angels bless Thee; Alleluia! Now the light has gone away; The daylight fades; All praise to Thee, my God, this night; Now the day is over; Saviour, breathe an evening blessing; O light, O trinity most blest!; Sun of my soul, Thou Saviour dear; The day is past and over; God, that madest earth and heaven; Abide with me, fast falls the eventide; The day Thou gavest, Lord, is ended; Day is dying in the west -- New year. Great God! We sing Thy mighty Hand; For Thy mercy and Thy grace; Another year is dawning; Our God, our help in ages past -- Harvest. We plough the fields, and scatter; Come, ye thankful people, come; Praise to God and thanks we bring -- Spring. For all Thy love and goodness -- Summer. Summer suns are glowing -- Autumn. The year is swiftly waning; See the leaves around us falling -- Winter. Winter reigneth o'er the land -- National.
