This text presents the results of an investigation into the selectivity biases of the Metropolitan Police of Bogotá. It is the result of the intersection of secondary and primary information, as well as data collected in the work of the District Commission on Criminal Policy. It is argued that, while the police share the same biases as Colombian society, some are exacerbated or amplified, and are also used for criminalization purposes. Examples of these biases are based on stereotypes related to class, race, ethnicity, gender, and other factors. Likewise, the efforts made by various sectors to transform and address these biases are highlighted. The text concludes with some recommendations
