In 2018, music journalist Niko Hüls set off on a trip to explore the roots of hip-hop in Germany. His journey was captured in the documentary 'Back to Tape' and was followed in 2020 with the documentary 'Back 2 Tape', chronicling his roadtrip through Europe in a Porsche Cayenne S Coupé. This book continues what the documentaries started; it is an insight into hip-hop as an all-embracing culture, and it highlights the impact that the four central elements of hip-hop -- rap, DJing, breakdance and graffiti -- have on cities. In this roadbook, Niko Hüls and the Back 2 Tape crew share very personal impressions of a journey to the roots and values of hip-hop in Europe
