The Libro Verde de Aragón circulated in handwritten form around 1560 in Aragonese society, of which it discredited the most prominent members. Indeed, his genealogies revealed their Jewish origin in broad daylight at a time when certain functions were reserved only for applicants who could prove the purity of their blood (without a Jewish or Moorish ancestor). Several of these texts have come down to us. We are studying one of them in this paper: Manuscript 22846 of the National Library of Spain. It is the largest of all the Libros Verdes. There appear therefore new and sometimes famous characters: Ruy Gómez de Silva, Juan Pérez de Oliván, Zurita, Antich de Bages, Doña Juana Pernstein, Duchess of Villahermosa, and Empress Doña María of Austria, sister of King Philippe II of Spain

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
