The Reform of Public Administrations report was recently presented, which was drafted by a specific Committee for the Reform of Public Administrations (CORA), and officially presented by four ministers and several high-ranking authorities. However, it was practically ignored and, due to its meaning, although not its material contents, it is examined in some detail in this article. This document, nearly 300 pages long, condenses what has been done -and still remains to do- in this area by the current government through a committee primarily made up of general directors of the state administration. CORA has created a total of 218 proposed measures, of which 11 are general and horizontal across all fields of the public administration; 119 are aimed at eliminating duplications between the autonomous communities and within the state; 41 remove formalities, simplifying procedures and making citizens' access to the administration more straightforward; 39 improve the management of shared services and resources; and eight rationalise the institutional administration, both in the regulatory sphere and by suppressing and integrating 57 public state institutions. Horizontal measures total 63, while the measures that affect concrete sectors number 155.
