The client, a young African American woman, opens the session with her concerns about "sabotaging" relationships--romantic and work relationships. The client expresses her general "fear of failure" and perfectionism stemming from her being sexually assaulted two years before; she also expresses a fear of being alone because of her inability to "love herself" and, thus, love others. Dr. Hays uses her categorization of life problems to identify those that the client can change (via awareness and better communications skills) and those that the client can learn to accept (via changing her thinking, acceptance, awareness)
